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- 1. Examination procedure for exams belonging to the winter term 20/21.**

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With great efforts on all sides, teachers and students alike have managed to successfully organize studies and teaching in the best possible way under the given conditions during this winter term, which is ending soon.

Our goal is now to conduct the upcoming examinations in the best possible way according to the criteria of quality, reliability and fairness. As announced in the "Letter to the Students" dated January 20, and based on the currently valid version of the "Corona Protection Order (CoronaSchVO)" and the "General Decree on the Implementation of Teaching and Practical Courses as well as Examinations at the Universities", on January 26 the Rectorate has therefore decided the following:

- 1) If the above criteria allow for, examinations should be offered in a distance format instead of in a presence format.
- 2) If this is not possible in the case of a written examination, such examination may take place in presence on the previously scheduled date. The prerequisite is that the examination cannot be postponed for legal or factual reasons or that postponing it would be unacceptable for the students. It should be noted that a short-term rental of additional halls on new dates cannot be guaranteed and that students should not be expected to take examinations belonging to the winter term during their studies in the summer term.

The examination boards are strongly requested to announce dates for examinations at least two weeks in advance or to announce that the previously planned and already announced dates will be kept.
