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1. Teaching in Summer Semester 21

The motto : "Provide opening possibilities, ensure plannability."

The University will hold the summer semester 2021 as an adaptive hybrid semester. This means:

a) We start on 12.04. based on the currently (10.03.) valid legal regulations: Presence only where absolutely necessary: lab practicals, practical training in sports and, possibly in musical or artistic modules. All other courses will be held in Uni@Home format.

Teachers: Please report the courses scheduled in presence format to the dean for approval. The requirement of traceability still applies. Because of changes in StudiLöwe, see point 2.

b) If tightening measures are ordered, they will be implemented immediately.

c) If the legal framework changes into a direction of more easings, possible easings will be decided by the rectorate. Study subjects can implement these easings, taking into account all other circumstances. The time required for the implementation is 10 days: possible changes might be implemented the week after next in the following of the rectorate's decision.

d) Once arrangements have been made, they will last for at least four weeks.

2. Courses in StudiLöwe

Course times: The times specified in StudiLöwe apply regardless of the format (Uni@Home or in attendance).

Rooms: In StudiLöwe, rooms are specified for many events. This informationon remains in place in the event that attendance mode becomes possible. Most courses, however, start in Uni@Home mode, see item 1.

Lecturers: Please add in StudiLöwe the specific Uni@Home format and the link to the Moodle course.

Students: Please inform yourself about the course schedule in Uni@Home format in the respective Moodle course (<u>https://moodle.uni-wuppertal.de/</u>).

3. StudiLöwe Introductory Session for first-semester students

On Tuesday, 13.04.2021 from 10 am - 12 pm, Dezernat 6 will offer a ZOOM introductory session on the use of StudiLöwe. Please register via Moodle (<u>https://moodle.uni-wuppertal.de/</u>) for the course "Einführungsveranstaltung StudiLöwe". After successful registration, you will receive the link for the Zoom meeting as well as the required password.

4. Rapid Covid-19 tests

It is conceivable that the use of rapid Covid-19 tests can support the return to more presence teaching. The responsible ministries have not yet issued any regulations on costs, implementation, binding nature, etc. As soon as details have been agreed and coordinated nationwide, the university will react accordingly.

5. Library

The library on the Grifflenberg Campus is now open to university members from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Mondays to Fridays. Subject libraries 1-5 are freely accessible. The number of people and the length of stay are limited. Admission is only possible after registration at the Central Information Desk. The two branches on Haspel Campus and Freudenberg Campus will remain closed until further notice. The ordering and pick-up service will continue to be offered for these, as well as for inventory from the magazine.

Until further notice, reading or workplaces in the library will not be accessible. The library will inform as soon as reservations can be made again.

6. Shutdown of HISinOne/StudiLöwe and WUSEL systems on 17 March

On 17 March, the HISinOne/StudiLöwe and WUSEL systems will be switched off for maintenance work.

Semester tickets cannot be printed on this day. The processing of any operations and queries in the Student Office and the central Examination Office will not be available.

As of Thursday, 18.03.2021, all systems are operating again.
