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- 0. Announcement concerning teaching with pyhsical presence**

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There will be another newsletter on the topic of presence teaching shortly. Namely then, when the details of the announced new general decree "Higher Education Institutions" of the MAGS will be known.

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1. WS 21/22: Lecture period, application deadlines NC degree programmes

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The MKW has redefined the following dates:

(1) Lecture period of WS 21/22: 11.10.2021 - 04.02.2022 (instead of 04.10.2021 - 28.01.2022)

(2) Application deadline for NC degree programmes: 31.07.2021 (instead of 15.07.2021).

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2. Examination planning for the summer semester completed

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The centrally executed planning of the presence examinations has been completed. The examinations will take place from 30.08 to 08.10. The former HAKO event arena in Wuppertal Vohwinkel has been rented as an additional examination hall with up to 150 seats. Seats are assigned to examination rooms in compliance with the current regulations on distancing.

All examination dates for all examination formats will be announced by the faculties or in the courses.

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3. Learning spaces on Campus

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BUW is once again offering corona-compliant learning spaces in the Uni@Home@Uni format in summer semester. Due to the conversion of the booking system to Moodle, places can now also be booked on the same day.

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6. Applying for the preparatory service for teachers in November

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Students who complete the M.Ed. in the summer semester and want to start the preparatory service on 01.11. should know: It is possible to apply with an incomplete degree by the MSB application deadline (usually mid-September). The university will then notify the MSB through ISL of the missing certificates. In this way, no disadvantages arise despite individual late examination dates.

Examiners: If applicable, give priority in marking these exams and submit results to the central examination office by October 11.

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7. Digitisation in University Teacher Education: "Combinatorial Bachelor 4.0".

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The project "Combinatorial Bachelor 4.0" at the University of Wuppertal pursues the goal of teaching all students of the Combinatorial Bachelor of Arts sustainable digital competences by the end of their studies. The basic module "Digital Competence" in the optional area of the combinatorial Bachelor of Arts degree programme, which has to be taken with 5 LP, is to be carried by all partial degree programmes. Digital competences based on this should then be incorporated into the subject curricula of the sub-degree programmes.

An adaptive user interface is currently being developed step by step. This is intended to visualise a flexible combination of learning modules for the students according to the necessity of the partial courses of study as well as their individual interests. In addition, it is to serve as an interface between already existing applications and those to be newly developed in order to also minimise organisational effort. Since the next cohort of students from the winter semester 2021/2022 onwards will already need a corresponding range of learning modules, the partial study programmes will be supported by a project team.

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8. Funding by the Foundation for Innovation in Higher Education Teaching

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The project "Development, implementation and integration of hybrid teaching/learning scenarios" is funded with approximately 2.7 million euros. The focus is on

- (1) adaptive digital learning opportunities in core subject areas in four faculties (Fk1, Fk3, Fk6, SoE) and in cross-disciplinary aspects of teacher education,
- (2) the conception on higher education didactics and the realisation of the hybrid formats.
