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1. Guideline for examinations

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On 30 August 2021, the period of examinations in presence format begins. The guideline for conducting presence format examinations has been updated and can be downloaded from the website pages of Department 5:

Most important points:

- 1) The participation in examinations is only permitted with a negative test proof or with proof of complete immunisation (vaccinated, recovered). The negative test proof must not be older than 48 hours. The proof of immunisation or the negative test certificate must be shown together with an official identification document to the supervising person (invigilator) when entering the examination room.
- 2) Wearing a medical mask or a standard FFP 2 mask is also compulsory during the examination.

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2. Teaching in Winter Semester 21/22

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Reminder: For your personal planning, continue to assume that most courses in the coming winter semester 2021/2022 will take place in presence format.

In addition, assume that attendance at courses will only be possible with proof of immunisation or negative test evidence.

Next Monday during the afternoon, 23.08.2021, the course catalogue for the winter semester 2021/22 will be accessible in Studilöwe. You will be able to see the rooms and dates for the planned presence format courses.

The basis for the actual organisation of winter semester 21/22 will be the legal regulations valid in October. As in the last one and a half years, we will have to live with the fact that changes in planning can occur at short notice.
