# 1. Vaccination offers at the university

------

Booster vaccinations with Moderna and BioNTech are already possible after only 5 months. The Bergische Universität offers two vaccination dates in cooperation with the city of Wuppertal:

on 22 and 23 December, both from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., at the Grifflenberg Campus in the foyer of Building K.

Please bring your identity card and vaccination card. Registration is not required!

## 2. Study facilitation extended

------

On 1 December, the Corona Epidemic Higher Education Ordinance was retroactively extended for another semester: <u>https://recht.nrw.de/lmi/owa/br\_vbl\_detail\_text?anw\_nr=6&vd\_id=19950</u>.

Until the end of March 2021, the following rules will therefore generally apply to all degree programmes (i.e. beyond the provisions of the respective examination regulations including annexes):

1. All examination attempts for courses of the winter semester 21/22 are free attempts without exception. (§7 Para. 4 Sentence 1)

- 2. Students who are in quarantine are considered to be ill for examination purposes and are therefore excused from attendance duties. (§7 Para. 4a)
- 3. The Rectorate will extend the deadline for providing proof to 30.09.2021 for those students who have enrolled in a Master's degree programme in the winter semester 2021/2022 with the requirement to provide proof of completion of the Bachelor's degree programme by 31.03.2021. (§11 Para. 1).

## 3. Examinations in spring

The written examinations for the courses of the winter semester 2021/2022 will - as of today - generally take place in presence again, taking into account the 3G regulations and the usual hygiene rules. Seating is 1.50m apart; a medical mask must be worn. The dates and locations are fully planned and are now being announced by the faculties.

#### 4. New learning room with digital equipment on T.11

------

As of now, the new learning room near the ZIM Benutzerberatung (user advisory service point) offers students the opportunity to work in groups. With its flexible furnishing, it is both an internet café and a discussion room. A first impression can be found here:
