The Corona Protection Ordinance of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia has been extended to hold until 02 April 2022. Regulations concerning teaching and examinations at universities remain unchanged. This means in particular:	
•	Anyone taking part in a teaching event or an examination has to prove his or her immunitary or testing status. This is why the check-in system with the paper bracelets is maintained. Within the buildings of the university and in all lecture rooms and halls, everyone must wear a medical face covering. FFP2 masks or comparable are recommended.
