3. New digital services for students

Uploading medical certificates:

Medical certificates for deregistring from limited repeatable examinations have to be submitted digitally. The administration of the Central Examinations Office (ZPA) will then initiate all further steps.

Uploading a thesis:

Since 1 October, the School of Mechanical Engineering and Safety Engineering has tested digital thesis uploads for single-subject degree programmes. The assessment of digitally submitted theses is carried out without media disruption. Examiners receive a document link sent by the administration of the Central Examinations Office (ZPA).

During individual caching sessions with psychologists, students are offered support in developing strategies for coping with difficult study and life situations. Problems that can occur in all stages of your studies are, for example


- Difficulties in learning and working
